**Committee Activities:**

**Scholarship and Awards Committee**

The Scholarship committee has reviewed the process and amounts to be given during 2010. The Nurses Care Scholarships are supported by the sale of the NURSES CARE license plate in South Carolina. These awards were increased to 5 Graduate and 10 Undergraduate Scholarships at \$1,500 each this year. Sadly however, the Ruth A. Nicholson Research Award, the Evelyn J. Entrekin Scholarship and the Appalachia Chapter Scholarship were not awarded this year due to the markets. Healthy Communities Grants also were not awarded in 2010 due to insufficient funds. **Marketing & Development Committee**

The ongoing activities of the Marketing & Development Committee include an annual campaign, quarterly articles in *SC Nurse*, the *Nurses Care* license plate initiative, the website and other fundraising initiatives. The annual campaign, “*Every Dollar You Donate Helps Someone Learn to Save a Life*” was launched in January 2010 and will run until the end of 2010. Information about the annual campaign is published quarterly, as well as on the web. The committee is working on possibly having a phone telethon within the year.

The quarterly articles in *SC Nurse* summarize the activities of the Foundation, and the website continues to be monitored on a regular basis. The Committee held its first state-wide *Nurses Walk* in Columbia in November of 2009. Because of statewide support we are planning to host the Nurses Walk on November 6, 2010 at a Columbia and Charleston site. The funds raised through the Walk will support the mission of the SCNF. **Nurse/Faculty Development Grants**

SCNF is in the third year of the grant from Blue Cross Blue Shield Foundation of South Carolina for faculty development. In May 2008, the BCBSFSC granted \$1.5 million over three years to establish graduate-level nursing scholarships through the South Carolina Nurses Foundation, Inc. The grant has provided financial support each semester through stipends to student nurses enrolled in PhD, DNP (\$20,000), and MSN (\$10,000) programs in SC who agree to become faculty in SC state-approved nursing education programs for a certain period of time. The grant is administered in cooperation with the three graduate nursing programs – Clemson University School of Nursing, Medical University of South Carolina College of Nursing, and University of South Carolina College of Nursing – who serve on an Advisory committee along with representatives of other nursing education programs.

Fifteen students are currently enrolled and six students have graduated, three have begun their service agreements employed as faculty in RN programs in South Carolina, two are seeking

employment and one is part time seeking full time employment. Outcomes Research is being conducted via survey and will be completed soon.

In 2009, The SC Department of Employment and Workforce (formerly DOC) awarded a grant of \$1.8 million over a three year period to impact the nurse faculty shortages in our state. The funds are part of the Workforce Investment Act funds distributed by the federal government. The terms and guidelines for the stipends are similar to those of the BCBSSC stipends but include part time and summer as well as the stipulation that the student finish studies by August 2012 when the funding comes to an end. PhD, DNP, and MSN students are eligible for the stipends as in BCBS. Currently there are twenty two students enrolled in this program.

The Foundation appreciates the opportunity to work with the Blue Cross/Blue Shield Foundation and the Department of Commerce in this endeavor. Renatta Loquist is Project Administrator for both grants. ### **Finance Committee**

The Finance Committee continues to monitor the Foundation's Investment Portfolio with Morgan Stanley. A Conservative Index has been utilized to maximize our investments this past year due to market uncertainty.

The Board approved Administrative fee of 1.5% annually continues for 2010 and will be utilized as operating capital. This fee is based on the closing balance as of December 31 in each of the investment accounts.

The Director's and Officer's Liability Policy, and a Dishonesty / Crime Policy were purchased with Sullivan Company in Greenville for 2010, and a General Liability Policy was added to cover activities of the Foundation, including the Palmetto Gold and the Walk.

The Foundation has also utilized discretion in the purchase of short term CD's at appropriate times to increase interest during market uncertainty.

McGregor and Company, LLP continues to manage the accounting aspects of the Foundation. The 990 for 2010 and Secretary of State Registration were submitted.

### **Palmetto Gold Steering Committee**

The Palmetto Gold Nurse Recognition and Scholarship Program celebrated its ninth anniversary on April 26, 2010 with the Palmetto Gold Gala at Seawell's Convention Center in Columbia, SC. Over 900 nurses have been recognized for their outstanding contributions to excellence in nursing in South Carolina. Nursing scholarships of \$1000 each have been awarded to almost 200 nursing students over the past eight years as well. In 2010 twenty-two undergraduate nursing scholarships and one graduate scholarship were awarded.

The 2011 Gala will be held at The Columbia Metropolitan Convention Center on April 9, 2010. This will be the **Tenth Anniversary** of the Palmetto Gold Nurse Recognition and Scholarship Program.

### **Bylaws Committee**

Current bylaws were reviewed. No changes were made.

**Policy and Procedure Committee**

The committee continues its work to create a formal policy and procedure manual for the future administrative workings of SCNF. This will be a continuing process for 2010-2011.

**Other activities of the Board of Trustees**

The Foundation Board has continued its membership in SCANPO.

We are also utilizing Conference America to hold conference calls for meetings of committees for members around the state in order to decrease travel for the Board.
